### **M. Erkin ARIBAL, MD**

Prof. Erkin Aribal graduated from Hacettepe University School of Medicine, Ankara, Turkey in 1986. He further completed his radiology residency training at Türkiye Yüksek İhtisas Hospital, Ankara, Turkey in 1991. He worked at Ankara Oncology Hospital as the chief of Breast Imaging and Interventional Radiology Units of Radiology Department between 1991 and 1996. Prof. Erkin Aribal is currently the active heads of Breast Imaging and Interventional Radiology Units at Marmara University Hospital in Istanbul since 1996. He is the founder of multidisciplinary breast center at his hospital in 2001. Prof. Aribal is currently the president of Breast Imaging Group at Turkish Society of Radiology. He is also an active member of Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiology Society of Europe (CIRSE), European Society of Breast Imaging, European Society of Radiology and Radiological Society of North America. Prof. Aribal has broad experience in radiology, interventional radiology, oncology imaging, breast imaging, radiologic contrast media and radiology department management. He is currently the Head of Radiology Department at SENATURK (Turkish Academy of Senology).



### **Edward AZAVEDO, MD, PhD**

Dr. Azavedo is an Associate Professor of Radiology at Karolinska Institute Faculty of Medicine and currently working as the Clinical Director of Mammography Unit at Department of Radiology at Karolinska Hospital, Stockholm, Sweden. He graduated from Faculty of Medicine at Karolinska Institute in 1981 and received PhD degree and board certification in Diagnostic Radiology at the same institute in 1989 and 1990, respectively. Dr. Azavedo also has board certification at Anatomical Pathology. He was an adjunct member of the faculty as Clinical Associate Professor at Department of Radiology, Michigan State University, USA between 1991-1996. Dr. Azavedo is currently the Managing Editor of Breast Section at eMedicine Radiology Book and President of Swedish Breast Imaging Society since 2004. He is currently the Member of Faculty at Radiology Department of SENATURK.



### **Gül ATALAY BAŞARAN, MD**

Prof. Gül Atalay Başaran graduated from Istanbul University, Cerrahpaşa Faculty of Medicine in 1993. She completed her Internal Medicine Residency at Marmara University Hospital, Istanbul in 1999. Prof. Başaran received her Medical Oncology Fellowship again at Medical Oncology Department of Marmara University Hospital in 2003. She also received DES "Dipom Etude Specialization" certificate on breast cancer in 2003. ### **Levent ÇELİK, MD**

Prof. Dr. Levent Çelik graduated from Istanbul University Istanbul Faculty of Medicine. In 1985 he started his radiology residency training at Haydarpaşa Numune Hospital, Istanbul. During his residency, he worked at departments of computed tomography, angiography and interventional radiology in Istanbul Faculty of Medicine. After completing his residency in radiology, he was assigned as staff radiologist at the same hospital. Prof. Çelik also received graduation degree on Business Management from Anadolu University in 1989. He hold the assistant professorship post in radiology unit at Haydarpaşa Numune Hospital in 1991. Further he was assigned as assistant chief of the radiology department at the same hospital in 1993. He attended Tabar's mammography training in San Diego in 1995. In 1998 Prof. Çelik was assigned as chief of radiology department at Siyami Ersek Thoracic-Cardiovascular Surgery Hospital. He became professor in 2004. He was the dean of Maltepe University School of Medicine between 2010-2011. He is a member of Turkish Radiology Association, Medical Imaging and Interventional Radiology and he is a member of breast imaging subspecialty working group of Turkish Radiology Association. Prof. Çelik is currently the director of Radiology Department at Maltepe University School of Medicine and Member of Faculty at Radiology Department of SENATURK.



### **Varol ÇELİK, MD**

Prof. Varol Çelik completed his medical education in 1984 and general surgery residency in 1990 at Istanbul University Cerrahpaşa School of Medicine. Prof. Çelik is currently working at Breast Surgery Unit in the same institution since then. Along with his academic activities in the university, he is also the current presidents of Turkish Federation of National Breast Societies and Turkish Senology Society. He is the associate editor of Journal of Breast Diseases and editorial board member of Journal of Breast Health. Prof. Çelik's main interest areas are local treatment of breast cancer and radioguided occult lesion localization. He is the Member of Faculty at Breast Surgery Department of SENATURK.



### **Vincenzo EUSEBI, MD, FRCPath**

Prof. Vincenzo Eusebi graduated from University of Bologna and he is currently working as Professor of Pathology at the same university since 1986. Prof. Eusebi is currently the director of the Service of Histopathology at Bellaria Hospital, University of Bologna since 1989. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Pathology (UK), Fellow of the Royal Society of Medicine (UK), Fellow of the Queensland Cancer Foundation, honorary member of the Societies of Pathology (Argentina) and Senology (Greece and Switzerland) and member of the American Association of Directors of Anatomic Pathology. Prof. Eusebi is the Managing Editor of Virchows Archiv (Journal of the European Society of Pathology), Associate Editor of International Journal of Surgical Pathology and European Chief Editor of Human Pathology. He is also the member of the editorial boards of American Journal of Pathology, Journal of Surgical Pathology, Applied Immunohistochemistry, Pathology Case Review, Seminars Diagnostic Pathology, Pathologica, Turkish Journal of Pathology and Asian Biomedicine. Prof. Eusebi is a member of editorial scientific board of the WHO books of breast (2003 & 2012) and endocrine tumours (2004) and the co-author of the AFIP Atlas "Tumors of mammary gland (2009)" as well.



### **Bahadır M. GÜLLÜOĞLU, MD, FACS**

Prof. Güllüoğlu graduated from Istanbul University, Istanbul Faculty of Medicine in 1991. After completing his general surgery residency in Marmara University in 1996, he founded Breast & Endocrine Surgery Unit at his university hospital in which he still runs the unit as chair since 1998. He also held associate faculty member post at Breast & Endocrine Surgery Unit at Bergen University School of Medicine, Haukeland University Hospital, Norway in 2000 and 2008. He is currently holding the position of full surgical professorship at Marmara University School of Medicine since 2009. He is the institutional research coordinator of European Organization for Research and Treatment of Cancer (EORTC) BreastCancer Group since 2005 and was elected to be an active Fellow of American College of Surgeons (ACS) in 2006. He is a member of faculty at European Academy of Senology (EAoS) at Dusseldorf, Germany and executive board member of EURAMA (European-Asian Society for Breast Diseases). He is the co-founder and currently the surgical coordinator of Marmara University Hospital Breast Center which is a full member of SenoNetwork. Prof. Güllüoğlu is the President of SENATURK and co-editor-in-chief of Breast Case.

### **Sylvia H. HEYWANG-KÖBRUNNER, MD, PhD**

Prof. Heywang-Köbrunner graduated at Ludwig-Maximilians-University Munich and received her board certification as a radiologist in 1990. She previously worked as staff member and assistant professor at Radiology Units in Klinikum Großhadern, LMU Munich and University of Leipzig, Germany. She was also the Vice Director of Diagnostic Radiology Unit at Martin-Luther-University Halle, Germany. She received the professorship title at Martin-Luther-University in Halle, Germany in 1996. Prof. Heywang-Köbrunner also worked as the Head of Department of Breast Imaging and Intervention, Klinikum rechts der Isar, Technical University Munich. She is currently a member of German Roentgen Society, European Society of Magnetic Resonance in Medicine, Radiologic Society of North America and New York Academy of Sciences. She is also the board member of German Senologic Society. Her interest areas include breast cancer screening and its data capture & reporting system, contrast-enhanced breast MRI and MRI-guided interventional procedures. Prof. Heywang-Köbrunner performed the very first MRI-guided percutaneous vacuum assisted breast biopsy in 1996. She is currently the Head of Scientific Committee of the Bavarian Breast Screening Program since 2004. She received many distinguished awards due to her contributions on breast cancer diagnosis including Holthusen-Ring Award in 1992, Institut International d'Imagerie Medical Award in 1994 and European Yvette Mayent Prize of the Institut Curie (Paris) in 1999. Prof. Heywang-Köbrunner is currently the Head of Reference Center for Mammography in Munich since 2005 and Head of Center for Breast Diagnosis Munich Radiologie Haidhausen since 2007.

### **Handan KAYA, MD**

Prof. Handan Kaya graduated from Istanbul University Istanbul Faculty of Medicine in 1988. She completed her pathology residency at Marmara University School of Medicine in 1996. Prof. Kaya received training on molecular pathology in UK between 1996-1997. She worked at Bologna University Breast Pathology Department in Italy as a visiting professor in 2000 and 2010. Prof. Kaya is currently the director of Pathology Department at Marmara University Research and Training Hospital since 2010. Along with her academic tasks, she is an active member of the European Screening Programme of the Breast Pathology and Breast Working Group. Prof. Kaya is currently the Head of Pathology Department at SENATURK.

### **Abut KEBUDİ, MD, FACS**

Prof. Kebudi graduated from Istanbul University, Cerrahpasa Faculty of Medicine in 1981. After completing his general surgery residency in Istanbul University in 1988, he worked as a general surgeon in Sisli Etfal Education and Research Hospital, Istanbul, where he received his Associate Professor Degree in 1998. He worked as a visiting professor in University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) Harbor hospital for oncological and breast surgery. Prof. Kebudi worked also at Istanbul University, Istanbul Faculty of Medicine, Breast Surgery Unit. He is currently holding the position of full professorship at Maltepe University School of Medicine since 2004. He is currently the head of the General Surgery Department and Breast Surgery Unit at Maltepe University, School of Medicine. He was elected as an active Fellow of American College of Surgeons (ACS) in 2006. He is a member of the Turkish Federation of National Breast Societies and also a member of board of governors at MAYMET. Prof. Kebudi is the Second Vice-President and Executive Director of SENATURK and executive board member of South-East European Chapter of EURAMA (European-Asian Society for Breast Diseases).

### **Christos J. MARKOPOULOS, MD, MPhil (UK), PhD**

Prof. Christos J. Markopoulos is associate professor of surgery in Athens University Medical School and currently the director of the Breast Unit at 'Laiko' University Hospital of Athens and Athens Medical Centre, Greece. He is qualified at Athens University Medical School in 1979 and specialized in general surgery (1985). He received his MPhil degree in Oncology-Breast Cancer at University of London, UK in 1988. He specialized in breast cancer management as senior registrar at the Breast Unit of St. George's Hospital and Medical School and at The Royal Marsden Hospital in London (1985-1988). He worked as a research fellow at Ludwig Institute for Cancer Research at Sutton, UK. He is a member of the British Association of Surgical Oncology (BASO), Association of Breast Surgery at The Royal College of Surgeons (ABS), American College of Breast Surgeons (ACBS), European Society of Surgical Oncology (ESSO). Prof. Markopoulos is the current member of the Executive Committees of the European Society of Breast Cancer Specialists (EUSOMA) and UEMS - Breast Surgery Working Group. Since 2000, he chairs The Hellenic Society of Breast Surgeons (HSBS) and he is responsible of the education and training and clinical trials section of the society. Prof. Markopoulos is the national representative of BIG, EBCTCG, member of the AIOG, national coordinator for various international trials and president or member of the scientific committees of Greek breast cancer advocacy groups and Europa Donna Hellas. He is the Member of Faculty at Breast Surgery Department of SENATURK, as well.

### Marco ROSSELLI DEL TURCO, MD

He is a member of the Scientific Committee of The Breast, director of the Italian journal *Attualità in Senologia* and member of the Editorial Board of *European Journal of Surgical Oncology*. Dr. Roselli is the Past-President of the European Society of Breast Cancer Specialists (EUSOMA).



### Cem YILMAZ, MD

Dr. Yılmaz was graduated from Ankara University School of Medicine and completed his general surgery residency at Ankara Numune Training Hospital. Dr. Yılmaz had the necessary training on breast diagnostics, oncoplastic surgery, health economics and quality management in breast cancer management at European Academy of Senology (EAoS), Dusseldorf.
